Tips from the Tee : Putting- Maintain Your Wrist Angles

If you are looking to improve the consistency of your putting pay close attention to the angles of your wrists. Those angles that are established at setup have to be maintained throughout the stroke and match when the putter is impacting the ball. Watch Jordan Speith next time. He putts with his left hand low with a significant amount of forward press. Basically his left arm is an extension of his putter shaft. He returns the putter to the exact same location at impact. Same loft every time with the putter face square. If the angles of your wrists are changing so is the putter face and that's not a good thing.



Warning Signs of Clothes Dryer Fire Hazard

If you notice any of these warning signs, consult a professional about proper cleaning, maintenance or repairs, and safety recommendations:

- The drying process seems uneven and inefficient
- The laundry takes much longer than normal to dry
- The laundry does not ever get thoroughly dry
- The exterior of the dryer feels very hot when you touch it
- Laundry starts to feel hotter than normal when a load is done
- There is less dryer lint than normal on the filter, indicating the dryer lint may be lodged inside the dryer instead of on the filter
- Laundry is damp or smells musty after drying – a sign of restricted air flow
- The dryer shuts off before the drying cycle is finished
- There is a lot of excess lint in back of the clothes dryer
- The exterior flap on the exhaust vent to the outdoors is partially closed or immobile – an indicator of restricted or blocked air circulation
- There is visible dryer lint accumulating on the exhaust vent or elsewhere
- There is dryer lint in less visible areas of the dryer and exhaust system
- The exhaust system is not as short and straight as possible, level and secured

Any of these red flags are a first alert to homeowners. They are easily prevented with proper installation or inspection of prior installations, careful cleaning following clothes dryer cleaning kit or other instructions, or hiring a professional to inspect, clean and maintain the system.

Fire safety experts advise homeowners to read and follow current standards for appliance care and fire prevention. In addition to important measures, such as smoke detectors and fire extinguishers, homeowners are urged to have an advance fire escape plan in place.

Walking Safety Rules

- **Walk Facing Traffic:** If there is no sidewalk and you must walk on the side of the road, choose the side where you are facing oncoming traffic. This gives you the best chance to see traffic approaching closest to you and take evasive action when needed.
- **Cross Safely:** Look both ways before crossing any street. Make eye contact with any drivers who may be turning. Give them a wave. Make sure they see you. **Walk Single File:** Unless you are on a sidewalk separated from the road or a wide bike lane, you should walk in single file. This is especially important on a road with lots of curves, where traffic has only a split second chance of seeing you before hitting you. While it can be enjoyable to walk down the road two to three abreast chatting merrily, drivers don't expect it and you may lose your best walking buddies.
- **Stay Aware of Bikes and Runners:** Share the road and path with bikes and runners. Bike riders should alert you when approaching from behind with a bike bell or a "passing on the left/right." Listen for them, and move to walk single file, allowing them to pass safely. Runners should also call out for passing. Bike-walker collisions can result in broken bones or head injury for either — and you aren't wearing a helmet.
- **Be Visible:** Wear bright colors when walking in daytime. When walking at night, wear light-colored clothing and reflective clothing or a reflective vest to be visible. Drivers are often not expecting walkers to be out after dark, and you need to give them every chance to see you, even at street crossings that have crossing signals. Be just as cautious at dawn or twilight, as drivers still have limited visibility or may even have the setting or rising sun directly in their eyes.
- **Be Predictable:** Make a practice of staying on one side of the path while walking rather than weaving randomly from side to side. Watch your arm motions, or you may end up giving a black eye to a silently passing walker, runner or biker.
- **Keep the Volume Down:** Don't drown out your environment with your iPod. Keep the volume at a level where you can still hear bike bells and warnings from other walkers and runners. Your audiologist will also thank you.
- **Hang Up and Walk:** Chatting on a cell phone while you walk is as dangerous as chatting while driving. You are distracted and not as aware of your environment. You are less likely to recognize traffic danger, passing joggers and bikers or tripping hazards. Potential criminals see you as a distracted easy target.
- **Walk Dogs on Short Leashes:** There are many tragedies of dogs running out in to traffic or getting into a fatal dog fight either off leash or on a very long leash. Don't trip up other walkers or bikers with poor control of your pet. Keep your pet and yourself safe by learning proper leash walking.
- **Know When to Stop Walking:** Heat sickness, dehydration, heart attack or stroke can strike walkers of any age. Learn the symptoms of medical emergencies and carry a cell phone to dial 911.
- **Be Aware of Stranger Danger:** Choose your walking route for paths frequented by other walkers, joggers and bikers. If you see someone suspicious, be prepared to alter your course or go in to a store or public building to avoid them. Acting alert and aware can convince bad guys to choose an easier target.
