## ***From the Management Office...***

### **2020 DIRECTORIES ARE IN!**

Please stop by the office to pick up your 2020 directory during office hours. Please only **ONE** per household until everyone gets a copy. Thank you

### **ATTENTION RESIDENTS**

To protect yourselves, please use licensed and insured contractors per the prospectus. It might be a good idea for you to know the background of anyone you invite onto your home site for any reason. You are responsible for the conduct of persons you invite into the community.

### **RENT IS DUE ON THE 1<sup>st</sup> of EACH MONTH**

Remember, your rent is due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. Late fees begin accruing after the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the month. To avoid late fees, please have your rent in the office by the 1<sup>st</sup>. If you have any questions, please refer to your prospectus. Automatic debit from your checking account is available, just call our office.

### **GOLF CARTS**

We are requesting that you do not let anyone drive your golf cart in the community under the age of 16. There have been complaints that underage children are driving golf carts in the community and almost hitting a person or persons. This is dangerous for the child and the community. We want to try and keep everyone safe. (see safety guidelines for golf cart operations)

### **GARBAGE, RECYCLE AND YARD WASTE**

Management is getting many complaints about garbage being put by the street too early. Please remember that Garbage, Recycle, and Yard Waste may be placed at the side of your driveway **no earlier than the night before pick-up**. If you have contracted someone to trim and weed your lot, please make them aware of our rules and regulations. Please do not put any debris on the storm drainage as we do not want anything to go into the water system that should not be there. It will also prevent the water to drain when needed.

### **TREE REMOVAL**

We have received many requests for tree removal. As a reminder, each homeowner will need to fill out a Design Specification Approval form and get approval from us for the tree removal. You or your contractor will need to get a permit from the City of Port Orange and you will need to replace each tree that is removed. We have a list of trees that you can get. It does not need to be placed in the same place nor does it need to be on your lot, but one will need to be donated to us and we will place it in the community. Please make sure these rules are followed.

### **DESIGN SPECIFICATION APPROVAL FORM: AS A REMINDER:**

**Anything** you do on the outside of your home, you need to fill out a **Design Specification Approval** form with all measurements, colors and diagram of what you would like to do. This includes tree removal, tree placement, adding concrete or additions, painting shutters, adding or changing windows, adding screen or anything else you want to do on the **outside of your home**. Once you fill out the form, we will either approve it or not and let you know. If a permit is required, you will need to get the permit from the City of Port Orange before you can start any of the work. You can pick up the form in the office or if you have any questions, please give us a call. Thank you.

### **POOLS AND SPA**

As a reminder, please make sure you accompany your guest to the pools, no horse playing or ball throwing while in the pools, no children in the heated pool or hot tub. We are asking to please **do not play your music loud** as some residents like to read or just relax. **There have been several complaints so please be considerate of everyone and follow all the rules.**

## **SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR GOLF CART OPERATIONS**



- Drivers and passengers must remain seated while the vehicle is moving
- Only experience drivers 16 or older should drive a golf cart
- Never exceed the number of available seats for the number of passengers
- Reduce speed when approaching pedestrians, Always yield the right of way
- Use the safety mirrors at each intersection to ensure pedestrian safety
- Do not park carts where they will block intersections or the normal traffic flow
- The maximum speed of a golf cart depends upon the terrain over which it is being driven, the weather conditions and the total weight of the golf cart, passengers and any equipment being carried.
- A golf cart should be operated at a speed equivalent to a well-paced walk but not faster than 20 MPH
- Observe all Florida vehicle traffic laws such as lane travel, stop signs, legal passing of other vehicles, etc.
- Drive on streets, cart paths or roadways whenever possible
- All passengers should keep hands, arms , legs and feet within the confines of the golf cart at all times when the cart is in motion
- When the golf cart is not in use, place the golf cart control lever in the off position, set the brakes and remove the key
- When the golf carts are not in use for a long period of time such as overnight or longer, secure it with a cable and lock.

## POOL & SPA RULES

### HEATED POOL

These facilities are for Crane Lakes Residents. All guests must be registered with the office or must display I.D. Residents are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Weekend guests must be registered with the office & I.D. must be obtained on Friday. This is not a public facility.

1. Guests may visit and use these facilities as specified in the Rules & Regulations. Each guest has thirty (30) days per year for visits/fifteen (15) days consecutively.
  2. Guest should not bring guests.
  3. All persons must wear correct swim apparel.
  4. Please shower before entering pool.
  5. No horseplay, running, or diving allowed
  6. No swimwear in the Clubhouse.
  7. Restrooms are located on the West Side. Showers are on the Southside of the pool Deck.
  8. Please remember that this facility is designed for the residents of Crane Lakes. All guests must follow the rules & refrain from disturbing the residents using these facilities.
  9. Pool hours are from 8:00 a.m. To 9:00 p.m.
  10. Bathing load is 26.
  11. No food or drink in the pool.
  12. No glass in the pool, spa, and/or pool deck.
  13. No animals in the pool, spa. Or on pool deck.
  14. No loud Radios.
  15. **Guest under the age of 18 are allowed in the heated pool only during the month November thru April.**
  16. **Toddlers must have swimming diapers (swimmies) to be allowed in the pool.**

### POOL RULES

2. Guest should not bring guests.

8. Toddlers must have swimming diapers (swimmies) to be allowed in the pool.

10. Pool hours are from 8:00 a.m. To 9:00 p.m.
11. Bathing load is 52.
12. No food or drink in the pool.
13. No glass in the pool, spa, and/or pool deck.
14. No animals in the pool, spa. Or on pool deck.
15. No loud Radios.

### SPA RULES

1. **For Crane Lakes Residents & their guests only. Resident must accompany Guests.**
2. No Glass Containers in SPA/POOL area.
3. **Shower before entering.**
4. **No one under (18) eighteen allowed in Spa.**
5. Bathing load is 8.
6. No Diving.
7. Temperature is controlled by management.

### **Just a Friendly Reminder : Crane Lakes Golf Lightning Policy**

When you hear thunder or see lightning suspend your play immediately and get indoors. Our sport is played outside and with that comes the inherent risk of dangerous weather. Weatherbug and My radar are commonly used apps that can be downloaded to help indicate dangerous weather. Typically, they use an 8 mile radius as an indicator when you should not be outside. They also recommend that there be a 30 minute “all clear” sign since the last lightning strike within that 8 mile radius of your location. Please remember that you are responsible for your actions as well as knowing when a dangerous situation is present.
