From the Management Office...

ATTENTION RESIDENTS

To protect yourselves, please use licensed and insured contractors per the prospectus. It might be a good idea for you to know the background of anyone you invite onto your home site for any reason. You are responsible for the conduct of persons you invite into the community.

RENT IS DUE ON THE 1st of EACH MONTH

Remember, your rent is due on the 1st of each month. Late fees begin accruing on the 7th day of the month. To avoid late fees, please have your rent in the office by the 1st. If you have any questions, please refer to your prospectus. Automatic debit from your checking account is available, just call our office.

POOLS AND SPA

It is that time of the year when the pool gets busy and crowded. Please make sure you and your guest follow the rules. There is a list posted for you to review at the pool, but I am including a copy in the courier also. Remember, no guest is permitted to bring a guest. We need to be considerate of everyone. This is an amenity for our residents and their guest only. Thank you in advance.

DRAINAGE

The rainy season will soon begin. After moderate to heavy rain, it is normal for water to be standing around your home. If you notice water is still standing 2 or 3 days after a rain event, without additional precipitation, please call the office so we may check the irrigation system for leakage. We are not responsible for water under your home.

SNOWBIRDS

If you are getting ready to leave for the summer, please be sure to inform the office when you will be leaving and when you are planning to return. This helps us to locate you if we need to contact you. Thank you in advance.

GOLF CARTS

We are requesting that you do not let anyone drive your golf cart in the community under the age of 16. There have been complaints that underage children are driving golf carts in the community and almost hitting a person or persons. This is dangerous for the child and the community. We want to try and keep everyone safe. (see safety guidelines for golf cart operations)

STEPS MOTORISTS CAN TAKE TO AVOID HITTING A CYCLIST

As a motorist, sharing the road with cyclists is inevitable and at times can be challenging if one is uneducated about traffic laws. Not being fully educated is what ultimately leads to fatal injury accidents

Drivers can easily be distracted from a number of vices and at the same time are rarely looking for anything on the road other than another vehicle. It is imperative to avoid distractions and keep an eye out for cyclists

Intersections are the number one locations where bicycle accidents occur, as drivers can easily miss sighting them, so be extra cautious.

To minimize risk and prevent hitting a cyclist while driving, follow these three easy steps and ensure you properly share the road with cyclists.

1. Drive Cautiously:

- Slow down when you encounter cyclists. Reducing your speed can drastically lessen the chance of accidents.
- Never tailgate cyclists or motorists. Be aware that either one may stop abruptly and following too closely may cause a collision.
- Be aware of hazards that cyclists may encounter and be prepared for the actions that they make take in order to avoid the hazards.

2. Respect Cyclists:

- Never flag a cyclist on if other vehicles are approaching. A cyclist may assume that since you flagged them on, their path is clear.
- Allow cyclists plenty of time to cross an intersection. Be aware that if other vehicles see you crossing the intersection, they may assume it is clear.
- Never honk your horn near a cyclist, this may startle them and cause them to fall off of their bike.

3. Pass with Care:

- Always double check your mirrors and look over your shoulder to avoid blind spots before switching lanes.
- Never speed up to pass a cyclist. This can cause vehicles behind you to not see the cyclist.

It goes without saying that caution is key to **avoiding bicycle accidents** while driving. However, by educating yourself and learning the rules of sharing the road with cyclists, you can help lower the number of fatalities that occur each year due to motor vehicle and bicycle collisions.



Florida's Bicycle Laws

In Florida the bicycle is legally defined as a vehicle. Bicyclists have the same rights to the roadways, and must obey the same traffic laws as the operators of other vehicles. These laws include stopping for stop signs and red lights, riding with the flow of traffic, using lights at night, and yielding the right-of-way when entering a roadway

Bicycle Regulations

- A bicyclist must obey all traffic controls and signals.
- A bicyclist must use a fixed, regular seat for riding.
- No bicycle may be used to carry more persons at one time than the number for which it is designed or equipped.
- At least one hand must be kept on the handlebars while riding.
- Parents and guardians must not knowingly allow a child or minor ward to violate any provisions of this section.
- Every bicycle must be equipped with a brake or brakes which allow the rider to stop within 25 feet from a speed of 10 miles per hour on dry, level, clean pavement.

Sidewalk Riding

- When riding on sidewalks or in crosswalks, a bicyclist has the same rights and duties as a pedestrian.
- A bicyclist riding on sidewalks or in crosswalks must yield the right-of-way to pedestrians and must give an audible signal before passing.

Lighting

- A bicycle operated between sunset and sunrise must be equipped with a lamp on the front exhibiting a white light visible from 500 feet to the front and both a red reflector and a lamp on the rear exhibiting a red light visible from 600 feet to the rear.
- Additional lighting is permitted and recommended.

Roadway Position

- A bicyclist who is not traveling at the same speed of other traffic must ride as close as practicable to the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway. A bicyclist may leave the right-most portion of the road in the following situations: when passing, making a left turn, to avoid road hazards, or ***when a lane is too narrow for a bicycle and a car to share safely.***
- A bicyclist operating on a one-way street with two or more traffic lanes may ride as close to the left-hand edge of the roadway as practicable.
- Persons riding bicycles upon a roadway shall not ride more than two abreast except on paths or parts of roadways set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles. Persons riding two abreast shall not impede traffic when traveling at less than the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under the conditions existing, and shall ride within a single lane.

Left Turns

- A bicyclist intending to make a vehicle left turn is entitled to full use of the lane from which the turn is made. After scanning, signaling, and moving to the center of that lane, the bicyclist must check the signal, and then proceed when it is green and safe to do so.
- In addition to the normal vehicle left turn, a bicyclist may proceed through the right-most portion of the intersection and turn as close to the curb or edge as possible at the far side. After complying with any official traffic control device, the bicyclist may proceed in the new direction.

Signaling Turns

- A signal of intention to turn must be given during the last 100 feet traveled by the vehicle before turning. If a bicyclist needs both hands for control, the signal need not be given continuously.
- A bicyclist may signal intent to turn right either by extending the left hand and arm upward or by extending the right hand and arm horizontally to the right side of the bicycle.

Tips from the Tee: Putting

At impact the putter should have the exact same amount of loft on the face as it did at address. In other words, the putter shaft shouldn't lean back or more forward than it did at address. I see players lose it both ways, leaning the shaft more forward therefore the face opens, or more back therefore the face closes. This greatly increases the likelihood the putter face will be square at impact and the ball will roll straight.





Happy May ❤️ to everyone....our weather continues to be simply divine which affords us more opportunities to get out and about. Hoping at least a few of you were able to visit Cedar Lakes Woods & Gardens last month! This month let's look at some things to do that are closer to home...Volusia County's Farmer's Markets!

DAYTONA: The oldest farmer's market in our area is the Daytona Farmer's Market a/k/a Market@Magnolia. This market runs every Saturday from 7AM to noon on Magnolia Avenue between Beach Street and Palmetto Avenue with plenty of parking on the street or in the parking lots behind Beach Street. Offerings at this site include locally sourced farm produce and foods, plants and flowers. Craft vendors retail their pottery, clothing, jewelry, yard art and homemade goods.

ORMOND BEACH: Next, lets travel a bit north to Ormond Beach where the Farmer's Market has reopened every Thursday from 8AM-1PM. They are located on S. Beach Street, David Hood Plaza in front of the Ormond City Hall. Their site offers fresh foods and veggies, locally prepared foods, sweet treats, honey, plants, baked goods, meat and Thai Cuisine. Keeping Your Home Safe: Burglary Prevention Tips

Many burglars will spend no longer than 60 seconds to try breaking into a home. Good locks -- and good neighbors who watch out for each other -- can be big deterrents to burglars.

CHECK THE LOCKS

Did you know that in almost half of all completed residential burglaries, thieves simply breezed in through unlocked doors or crawled through unlocked windows?

- Make sure every external door has a sturdy, well-installed dead bolt lock. Key-in-the-knob locks alone are not enough.
- Sliding glass doors can offer easy access if they are not properly secured. You can secure them by installing commercially available locks or putting a broomstick or dowel in the inside track to jam the door. To prevent the door being lifted off the track, drill a hole through the sliding door frame and the fixed frame. Then insert a pin in the hole.
- Lock double-hung windows with key locks or "pin" windows by drilling a small hole into a 44° angle between the inner and outer frames, then insert a nail that can be removed. Secure basement windows with grilles or grates.
- Instead of hiding keys around the outside of your home, give an extra key to a neighbor you trust.

CHECK THE DOORS

- A lock on a flimsy door is about as effective as locking your car door but leaving the window down.
- All outside doors should be metal or solid wood.
- If your doors don't fit tightly in their frames, install weather stripping around them.

Install a peephole or wide-angle viewer in all entry doors so you can see who is outside without opening the door. Door chains break easily and don't keep out intruders.



Some tips to help move through the ticket line quickly:
