RENT INCREASES.CABLE AND GOVERNMENT & UTILITY CHARGES

By this time, you should have received your rent increase notice. Please remember the new amount takes effect **January 1, 2024**. The government and utility charges are due at that time as well. You may begin paying the government and utility charges before that date, **but it must be paid in full by the 1st of January 2024 to Crane Lakes.** Please indicate what you are paying for on your check. **The total amount for the government and utility charge is \$801.87.** Residents who have signed the form in the past few years for their taxes to be automatically deducted from their checking/savings account will be taken out again this year in the month of January 2024. If you are not sure if you did, please call the office. **Please note: Cable Fee will increase January 1, 2024 to \$65 .00.**

WATER UNDER YOUR HOME?

Occasionally management receives complaints that some residents have water under their home. Crane Lakes is not responsible for water going underneath your home unless it is a sprinkler issue. If you believe a sprinkler is the problem, we can gladly assist you in that regard; otherwise, water issues under the home are the residents' responsibility. It may be your downspouts, curbing, heavy rains or other issues causing the problem. Many residents have installed drains under their home at their own expense.

GARBAGE, RECYCLE AND YARD WASTE

Please remember that Garbage, Recycle, and Yard Waste may be placed at the side of your driveway no earlier than the night before pickup. If you have contracted someone to trim and weed your lot, please make them aware of our rules and regulations. Please do not place anything on the grass!!! Remember pick up days are: Monday-Large Yard Trash (Claw pick-up) & Recycle, Tuesday – Garbage., Wednesday – Small amount of Yard Trash, Friday-Garbage

RESIDENT LANE AT GATEHOUSE

Please note: If you are driving in on the resident lane at the gatehouse be sure to yield the right-a-way to the guest lane. **They do have the right-a-way coming into the community.** There is a stop sign on the gatehouse side as you are driving up to the gatehouse. Sometime people do not stop as they should putting our gatehouse attendant in danger. Please make sure you and all your guest stop at the gatehouse before entering Crane Lakes. We also ask when approaching the reader, please do at a slow speed. We want to make sure everyone is safe.

SOLID WASTE NEWS

Waste Pro (386)-492-8855

NOTICE: Schedules have changed for Recycling and Large Yard Waste collection.

Route changes for Recycling and Large Yard Waste will be effective on May 1, 2022

Solid Waste Collection – Please have material curbside by 7:00 am to ensure collection! Waste Pro can collect from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm.

Basic Garbage Service – This service includes two (2) weekly collection of garbage and household trash from places of residents. Household garbage must be placed in watertight plastic bags in garbage cans with suitable handles. **The cans should NOT exceed 32-gallon capacity, or 50 pounds in weight.** Any containers larger than 32 gallons much have debris bagged for easy and safe removal. **Weekly pick-ups are every Tuesdays and Fridays.**

Basic Yard Waste Service – This service includes one (1) weekly collections of yard waste each **Wednesday**, bagged in garden-sized plastic bags, boxed bundles, or place in garbage cans, **not to exceed 50 pounds in weight.**

Large Yard Waste Pile Service-Requiring Claw Truck - Accumulations or piles of yard waste will be picked up once a week on **Mondays only**. **Please Note:** An additional charge may apply to yard waste that exceeds 4 ft. in length or 18 in. in diameter or more than 5 cubic yards. **If you hire a tree service to trim or remove trees, they MUST remove debris at their own expense.**

Residential Recycling Service – Basic Recycling Service - Please have material curbside by 7:00 am to ensure collection. Limit three (3) bins per household. This service includes one (1) weekly collection of recyclable materials placed on one (1) or more containers approved by the City and designated for recycling purposes.

Weekly Recycle day now on Mondays!!!!

Please read the following information carefully to avoid contamination recycling loads which could be refused at market. Non-recyclable materials will be left in your bin to let you know that item is not recyclable. Cardboard boxes should be flattened and place in recycle bins. If you have large boxes, cut or fold to not larger than **5' x 5'** and place in between or under your bin.

No Styrofoam, plastic bags or glass. Grocery bags can be recycled at most grocery stores.

SPECIAL SERVICES & INFORMATION

Bulk Household Items such as Furniture, Carpet, etc. – These items may be placed curbside on your household garbage collection day.

This includes residential remodeling construction debris provides the resident DOES the work. Licensed contractors **MUST** remove debris at their own expense.

Appliances and White Goods – Large appliances are collected by Waste Pro and separated for recycling. Please place them curbside on your household garbage collection day. Doors of refrigerators must be removed for safety. Consider contacting a charitable or non-profit organization if the item is still usable.

Automobile Tires and Batteries – Tires and batteries should be placed curbside on your household garbage collection day. Waste Pro will collect these with a special truck so they are **NOT** commingled with household garbage. Limit 8 tires and 2 batteries per household per year.

Motor Oil – Motor Oil is banned from landfill disposal to protect water supplies. Recycle used oil only at recycling igloos at county fire stations and other facilities. Please visit www.volusia.org/services/publix/works/solid_waste_and_recycling/recycling/recycling_drop_off_sites

Used Paint – Waste Pro will not pick-up paint, thinners or solvents. Tomoka Landfill has a free paint exchange program and collects unused paints, in turn donating them to on-profit organizations and families in need. Call (386) 943-7889 or drop off at 1900 Tomoka Farms Road.

Sharps – Improper disposal of hypodermic needles for diabetes or other illness could pose a public health hazard. Port Orange residents can drop off sharp containers to Port Orange Fire Department#73 at City Center or Volusia County Health Department for proper disposal. Please keep the safety of our employees in mind.

Cooking Oil – Please place cooking oil in a container and contact Waste Pro at 386-492-8855 to arrange for pick-ups. This will prevent oil spills on the road.

Electronic Recycling – Residents may drop off obsolete electronics including TV, computers, monitors, printers, and cell phones at the Tomoka Landfill, free of charge.

Propane tanks – Residents may drop off obsolete and expired propane tanks at the Tomoka Landfill, free of charge.

Service to Handicapped – Upon request, door service to handicapped residents will be provided if there are no able-bodied persons in the household. Requests, along with a doctor's statement, should be submitted to Solid Waste Manager, 407 Virginia Avenue, Port Orange, FL 32127 or faxed by your Doctor to 386-756-5365.

Holidays – Collection will be done on all holidays except Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day. Collection for these days will be rescheduled. The schedule will be noted in the City's Fall Newsletter, on the city website and an advertisement will appear in The Daytona Beach News Journal.



News from the Golf Course

Golf Rule: Red Penalty Areas (Rule 17.2) = 5 options for 1 penalty stroke

- 1. 2 Club lengths form the margin of the penalty area*
- 2. Back on line relief keeping the point the ball last crossed the margin of the penalty area and the flagstick in line*
- 3. Replay the last Shot*
- 4. Go in the Penalty area and hit the ball*
- 5. Equal and Opposite sides within 2 club lengths of the margin*
(Not often feasible here at CL because of the OB on the other side of the water)
 - *The Ball Drop Area, if available would be a 6th option*

Tips from the Tee: STRETCH! STRETCH! STRETCH!

Stretching is the #1 thing you can do help you do to play better. Your body will thank you. It takes about five minutes each day. For golf focus on your hamstrings, lower and upper back, and your hips. Get your core temperature up a little bit by taking a walk or something then give it 5 minutes. Stretching will help you play better and play longer.



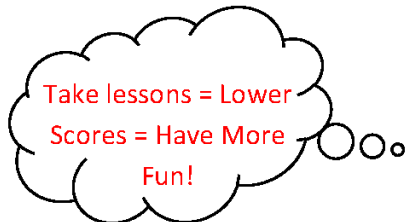
