2023 DIRECTORIES ARE IN!

Please stop by the office to pick up your 2023 directory during office hours. Please only **ONE** per household until everyone gets a copy. Thank you

ATTENTION RESIDENTS

To protect yourselves, please use licensed and insured contractors per the prospectus. It might be a good idea for you to know the background of anyone you invite onto your home site for any reason. You are responsible for the conduct of persons you invite into the community.

RENT IS DUE ON THE 1st of EACH MONTH

Remember, your rent is due on the 1st of each month. Late fees begin accruing after the 7th day of the month. To avoid late fees, please have your rent in the office by the 1st. If you have any questions, please refer to your prospectus. Automatic debit from your checking account is available, just call our office.

CAMPAIGN SIGNS

As a reminder, we allow one **(1) campaign sign** only during the months of October and November (until Election Day on Tuesday) to be placed in your flower bed. They may not be on the home or in the grass. Thank you

GOLF CARTS

We are requesting that you do not let anyone drive your golf cart in the community under the age of 14. There have been complaints that underage children are driving golf carts in the community and almost hitting a person or persons. This is dangerous for the child and the community. We want to try and keep everyone safe. (see safety guidelines for golf cart operations)

GARBAGE, RECYCLE AND YARD WASTE

Management is getting many complaints about garbage being put by the street too early. Please remember that Garbage, Recycle, and Yard Waste may be placed at the side of your driveway **no earlier than the night before pick-up**. If you have contracted someone to trim and weed your lot, please make them aware of our rules and regulations. Please do not put any debris on the storm drainage as we do not want anything to go into the water system that should not be there. It will also prevent the water to drain when needed.

Parking in Neighbor's Driveways

The management office has received complaints about parking in snowbirds or other residents' driveways while they are not here. Please **DO NOT** Park in anyone's driveway unless you have permission from the homeowner even if they are away. They can have your vehicle towed so please call the homeowner first. If you have any questions, please call the management office.

INSPECTIONS IN JULY

Inspections were done in July so please if you received a letter concerning your lot or home, we are asking that you complete what needs to be done to prevent receiving another letter. Remember, items stored in your carport may not be visible from the street. We appreciate your help with keeping Crane Lakes a wonderful community to live in. The entire community speed limit on our streets is **20 MPH**.



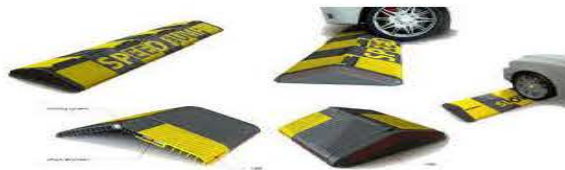
It is important to remember the streets are all shared by people doing the following:

Then coming up this fall:

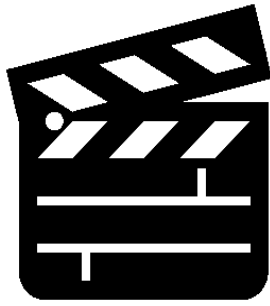
- September - First Sip & Paint


