ATTENTION RESIDENTS

RENT INCREASES AND GOVERNMENT & UTILITY CHARGES

By this time, you should have received your rent increase notice. Please remember the new amount takes effect January 1, 2024. The government and utility charges are due at that time as well. You may begin paying the government and utility charges before that date, **but it must be paid in full by the 1st of January 2024.** Please indicate what you are paying for on your check. **The total amount for the government and utility charge is \$801.87.** Residents who have signed the form in previous years for their taxes to be automatically deducted from their checking/savings account will be taken out again this year. If you are not sure if you did, please call the office.

DAYLIGHT SAVING

As a reminder, Sunday, November 5, 2023, marks the end of Daylight Saving Time. On Sunday, November 5, 2023, **2:00:00 am** clocks are turned **backward** 1 hour. Evenings will have more daylight and mornings will have less.

GARBAGE, RECYCLE AND YARD WASTE

Please remember that Garbage, Recycle, and Yard Waste may be placed at the side of your driveway no earlier than the night before pickup. If garbage is put out the night before it must be in a can so critters cannot get in it. If you have contracted someone to trim and weed your lot, please make them aware of our rules and regulations.

Please be reminded that pets must be on a leash at all times and are not allowed to be tied up outside or running loose at any time. 1. ANY AND ALL TREES (INCLUDING PALM TREE'S) THAT CAN/WILL GROW ABOVE 10 FEET NEEDS A PERMIT. CREPE MYRTLES OR FRUIT TREES ARE EXAMPLES OF TREES THAT DO NOT NEED A PERMIT.
2. IF THE TREE IS DYING/DEAD – YOU STILL NEED A PERMIT – YOU WILL JUST NOT BE CHARGED FOR THE PERMIT.
3. EACH LOT HAS TO HAVE AT LEAST 2 TREES. IF THEY REMOVE ONE OF THE 2 TREES, THEY DO HAVE TO REPLACE 1, .
4. WE HAVE A LIST IN THE MANAGEMENT OFFICE OF REPLACEABLE TREE IF THEY WOULD LIKE TO PICK ONE UP.
5. TREE REMOVAL PERMIT APPLICATION ATTACHED.
6. TO TRIM A TREE, YOU DO NOT NEED A PERMIT.
7. IF YOU HEAR OR SEE ANY TREE COMPANY OR RESIDENT TAKING TREES DOWN WITHOUT A PERMIT PLEASE CONTACT MANAGEMENT OFFICE

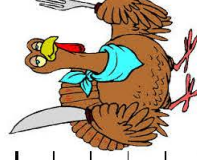


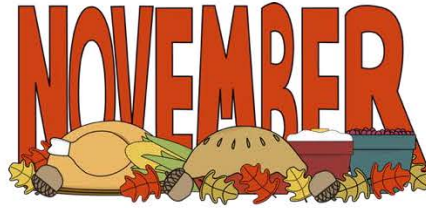
