### **RENT INCREASES AND GOVERNMENT & UTILITY CHARGES**

Please remember the new amount for your new lot rent takes effect **January 1, 2024**. The government and utility charges are due at that time as well. You may begin paying the government and utility charges before that date, but it must be paid in full by the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2024. Please indicate what you are paying for on your check or money order. **(AS ALWAYS, PLEASE INCLUDE YOUR LOT NUMBER ON YOUR CHECK OR MONEY ORDER)**. **The amount for the government and utility charge total is \$801.87.** Residents who have their rent automatically deducted from their checking/savings account will need to send payment for this amount to our office as it is not automatically deducted unless we were instructed to do so. Please call the office if you are not sure.

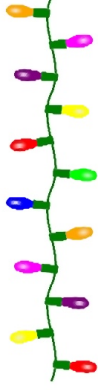

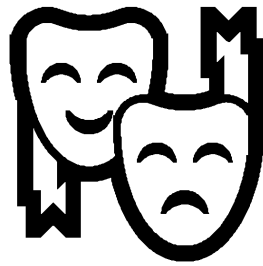

I participate in some open groups that meet once a month. Each month, in the open group, there are a few new faces and some who are there every month. I find these groups very helpful in different ways. I find it comforting to be in a room surrounded by people who understand what we are all dealing with. I have been encouraged by my counselor and others who have helped me on this journey to facilitate a support group for widows and widowers here in our community. We can help each other even when we cannot seem to help ourselves. If you are interested, give me a call. Our first gathering will be Thursday, December 7, 2023 at 10:00 at my home, 5603 Bald Eagle. At this meeting we will decide how often we want to meet and set dates for future gatherings.
