House and Senate bills have been changed so the language is identical, so HB 613 SB 1140 will now be CS/SB 1140. Democrat member, Joe Casello, said he was glad to vote on the bill as he received more than 1,100 e-mails in support of the bill. This bill will address several issues in the event the homeowner must have a live-in healthcare aide or assistant.

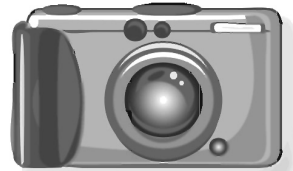

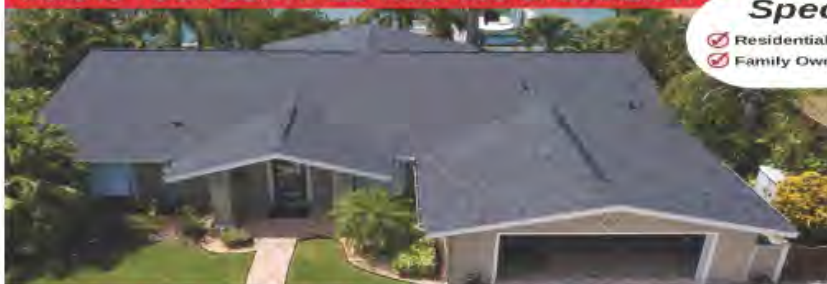
