From The Management Office...

Please stop by the office to pick up your 2025 directory during office hours. Please only ONE per household until everyone gets a copy. Thank you

ATTENTION RESIDENTS

To protect yourselves, please use licensed and insured contractors per the prospectus. It might be a good idea for you to know the background of anyone you invite onto your home site for any reason. You are responsible for the conduct of persons you invite into the community.

RENT IS DUE ON THE 1st of EACH MONTH

Remember, your rent is due on the 1st of each month. Late fees begin accruing after the 7th day of the month. To avoid late fees, please have your rent in the office by the 1st. If you have any questions, please refer to your prospectus. Automatic debit from your checking account is available, just call our office.

GOLF CARTS!

We are requesting that you do not let anyone drive your golf cart in the community under the age of 14. There have been complaints that underage children are driving golf carts in the community and almost hitting a person or persons. This is dangerous for the child and the community. We want to try and keep everyone safe. (see safety guidelines for golf cart operations)

GARBAGE, RECYCLE AND YARD WASTE

Management is getting many complaints about garbage being put by the street too early. Please remember that Garbage, Recycle, and Yard Waste may be placed at the side of your driveway **no earlier than the night before pick-up.** If you have contracted someone to trim and weed your lot, please make them aware of our rules and regulations. Please do not put any debris on the storm drainage as we do not want anything to go into the water system that should not be there. It will also prevent the water to drain when needed.

PARKING IN NEIGHBOR'S DRIVEWAYS

The management office has received complaints about parking in snowbirds or other residents' driveways while they are not here. Please **DO NOT** Park in anyone's driveway unless you have permission from the homeowner even if they are away. They can have your vehicle towed so please call the homeowner first. If you have any questions, please call the management office.

GARBAGE CANS REQUIRED

When putting your garbage out for pick-up, it is now a requirement to have it in a garbage can. The State came into Crane Lakes and did an inspection and noticed that there were some homes with garbage out for pick-up only in a bag. They informed me that your garbage is required to be in a garbage can for pick-up. The City does not provide them because we are a private community. Please have your garbage in a can which will also help prevent animals from tearing your bags and making a mess. We appreciate your cooperation.



GARBAGE CAN REQUIREMENT

The State of Florida conducted an inspection of Crane Lakes recently and cited our community for violation of section 64E-15.007 of the Florida Administrative Code. This section reads as follows:

Chapter 64E-15, Florida Administrative Code

Mobile Home, Lodging, and Recreational Vehicle Parks and Recreational Camps

Section 64-15.007 Garbage and Refuse Disposal

- (1) Garbage and refuse shall be stored, collected and disposed of in a manner that does not create nuisances, odors, rodent harborage, insect breeding, accident hazards, or air pollution.
- (2) All garbage shall be stored in containers that are impervious to water and rodent vectors and have tight-fitting lids. Containers shall be provided in number to prevent garbage overflow. Portable bulk units for central storage shall be covered when not in use and cleaned on a scheduled basis.
- (3) All garbage shall be collected twice weekly or in accordance with the frequency of the collection jurisdiction and transported in covered vehicles or covered containers. Burning of refuse in the park or camp is prohibited, except in incinerators for which the design and location has been approved by the Department of Environmental Protection. Refuse shall be transported and disposed of in accordance with provisions of Chapter 62-701, F.A.C., Solid Waste Management Facilities.

Rulemaking Authority 381.011, 513.05 FS. Law Implemented 381.006(4), (14), 386.041, 513.012 FS. History-New 5-20-96, Formerly 10D-26.160, Amended 12-30-09.

The State of Florida will conduct a follow-up inspection and can impose penalties if our community is not in compliance with the code at that time. These penalties are likely to be passed on to the non-compliant residents. Unfortunately, we have been told that the City of Port Orange does not provide garbage cans.

Please place your garbage in a can to comply with the code and to prevent animals from tearing your bags and making a mess.




Golf RULE of the Month

Rule 12: Bunkers

12.2a Removing Loose Impediments and Movable Obstructions

Before playing a ball in a bunker, a player may remove loose impediments and movable obstructions. This includes any reasonable touching or movement of the sand in the bunker that happens while doing so.





Tips from the Tee

Use the entire teeing area to your advantage. The teeing area is not just a straight line in between the two tee markers. A player may move back up to 2 club lengths behind the markers. This comes in handy on par threes when the distance to the hole leaves you stuck in between clubs. Say for example the distance on a given par 3 is 105 yards. My full Sand Wedge carries 100 yards and my full Gap Wedge carries 115. I would use the entire teeing ground to my advantage and go back the two driver club lengths which is basically 3 yards. Now I have 108 yards. That's much closer to my stock Gap Wedge leaving me a full shot.




