# From The Management Office...

## **ATTENTION RESIDENTS**

To protect you, please use licensed and insured contractors per the prospectus. It might be a good idea for you to know the background of anyone you invite onto your home site for any reason. You are responsible for the conduct of persons you invite into the community.

## **RENT IS DUE ON THE 1st of EACH MONTH**

Remember, your rent is due on the 1st of each month. Late fees begin on the 7th day of the month. To avoid late fees, please have your rent in the office by the 1st. Late fees **WILL BE CHARGED** on the 8th day, no exceptions.

## **RENT INCREASES AND GOVERNMENT & UTILITY CHARGES**

Please remember the new amount for your new lot rent takes effect **January 1, 2026**. The government and utility charges are due at that time as well. You may begin paying the government and utility charges before that date, but it must be paid in full by the 1st of January 2026. Please indicate what you are paying for on your check or money order. **(AS ALWAYS, PLEASE INCLUDE YOUR LOT NUMBER ON YOUR CHECK OR MONEY ORDER)**. **The amount for the government and utility charge total is \$937.89**. Residents who have their rent automatically deducted from their checking/savings account will need to send payment for this amount to our office as it is not automatically deducted unless we were instructed to do so. Please call the office if you are not sure.

**CABLE FEE** - will be \$68.50 per month starting January 1, 2026. **Very important** –For any questions for your service or billing, please call **833-697-7328**. You will want to keep the number handy for the future. Any questions, please call the office. **Please make sure you are not double billed for the service that is included in your contract.**

## **HOLIDAY DECORATIONS**

Please make sure your decorations are in your flower beds or on your home. Please do not put them in the yard as they may come in contact with our lawn equipment. We will not replace any decorations, nor reimburse our residents for damaged decorations that are left in the lawns.

## **REMINDER: GATEHOUSE POLICIES**

As a reminder, any family and/or friends that come into Crane Lakes after 10 pm, please call the gatehouse to let them know that you will be having visitors after 10 PM. They will try and call you no matter what time it is. # Golf RULE of the Month

## Local Rules

---

Sprinkler heads close to the greens are often given special consideration through the adoption of a special local rule. Local rules are rules that are specific to the golf course being played and are typically recognized on the scorecard or in prominent locations. What it typically says is that if the golf ball and the sprinkler head or vent lay with two club lengths of the green, line of play relief is granted. The player would then be able to lift, clean, and drop the ball within 2 club lengths of where the original ball lays. WE HAVE NOT ADOPTED this local rule here at Crane Lakes. Therefore, the only way relief is granted is if the ball or the players stance is affected by the sprinkler head.

## Tips from the Tee

### “Tricks” The Best Players Use...

Get low in Greenside Bunkers! If you want to hit the ball high and make the ball land softly out of greenside bunkers you need to take a wide stance (slightly wider than driver) you would and get the handle of the golf club low at address and impact. These are “tricks” that the best players use to hit incredible greenside bunker shots.



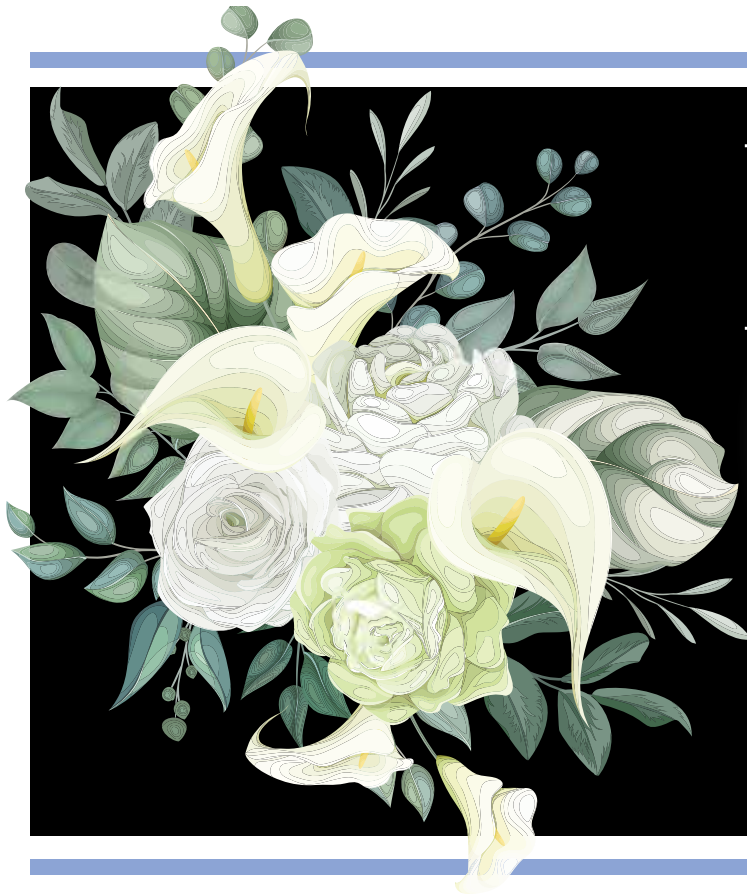
