ATTENTION RESIDENTS

DRAINAGE

The rainy season will soon begin. After moderate to heavy rain, it is normal for water to be standing around your home. If you notice water is still standing 2 or 3 days after a rain event, without additional precipitation, please call the office so we may check the irrigation system for leakage. We are not responsible for water under your home.

CRANE LAKES ONLINE PAYMENTS

FINAL NOTICE - ACTION REQUIRED

If you wish to continue making payments by ACH (bank transfer), you must switch to the new online payment system. The correct payment system is being discontinued and will no longer be available as of April 15, 2026.

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR YOU

- You will no longer be able to use the old system
- To continue ACH payments (no-fee option), you must register in the new system
- Residents who do not switch may experience payment disruptions

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO NOW

- Locate the letter or email previously sent to you

Prevention Tips to Stop Scammers

Imposters are real, but their requests are not. Don't be fooled, no matter how "real" or "urgent" they seem. Their goal is to deceive, yours is to detect and protect.

STOP — Don't let anyone rush you. If someone asks for money or personal info and it feels "off," it probably is. Trust your instincts and don't engage with them.

VERIFY — Even if the request appears legitimate, talk it over with someone you trust, like a friend or family member. You can call back using trusted and known numbers, such as those listed on the back of your debit or credit card or on your statement.

PREVENT — Knowing the signs of a scam and sharing them with family and friends can build community awareness. Help others stay alert and avoid scams by spreading the word.

PROTECT — Don't reuse passwords or PIN numbers for multiple accounts. Create complex passwords. Use two-factor authentication and biometrics that create additional steps to your account access.



Watch for Red Flags



Surprise! An unexpected call, text, email or social media message can catch you off guard. Be aware of common scam tactics. They change all the time, but the red flags remain the same. Even if a story makes sense, verify the information through a trusted source.

FALSE URGENCY — Scammers may say there's a problem that needs your immediate attention. They want you to act before you think, so they'll rush you into making hasty decisions. Slow down and consult with a friend or family member.

EMOTION — Scammers use stories to make you feel fear, greed, sympathy or love and urge you to ignore your instincts or lie about why you're moving money.

IMPERSONATION — They'll pretend to be an official, company representative, bank, or even a friend or family member.

DECEPTION — You may be instructed not to trust your bank, told to ignore warning messages or coached on what to say — including to lie.

REWARDS OR THREATS — They may offer money, a job, a prize, make claims of an emergency, or threaten you with legal action or notifying law enforcement.

UNUSUAL PAYMENTS — Scammers may tell you to send money or payment in a less common way, such as a wire transfer, gift cards, or non-traditional forms of payment like gold, cryptocurrency or pre-loaded debit cards.

VERIFICATION CODES — Scammers may try to "confirm" your identity with a verification code that appears to come from your bank but was triggered by the scammer. It's a red flag if they called you.

Golf RULE of the Month

Red Penalty = 5 Options (Plus Drop Zones if offered): _____

1. 2 Club lengths from the reference point. Reference point is where the ball LAST crossed the margin of the penalty. You can use any club to measure other than a putter.
2. Keep the reference point and the flagstick in line and go back as far as you want on that line.
3. Equal and opposite sides. You can go to the opposite side of the penalty an equal distance from the flagstick and drop a ball within 2 club lengths of the reference point.
4. Replay the previous shot
5. Get in the Penalty area and Hit it!

In addition to these 5 options, Drop Zones may be offered on certain holes. The Drop Zone on #14 here at Crane Lakes is only intended for those shots where an attempt was made to hit the green. Players may NOT use the drop zone for tee shots, errant shots, or lay ups that find the water. The players honest intent must have been to carry the water.

Tips from the Tee

RUN ON

When the body stops turning in the backswing the arms should stop swinging. "Run on" is what I refer to it as and it leads to a lot of inconsistency in the golf swing. The goal of an athletic golf swing should be to have a nice full shoulder turn with a relatively short arm swing. When the arms keep swinging, they become disconnected from the body rotation and that leads to bad golf swings. Try hitting some short irons with a small towel under your arms and across your chest. You will get the feeling instantly!

Just a Friendly Reminder: Why We Aerify

We aerify for a couple of reasons. First of all, it reduces the compaction of the turf. Compaction leads to poor root development, bad water percolation rates and a bad playing conditions. The second benefit it allows trapped gasses in the soil profile to be exchanged. Another benefit is that it reduces thatch build up. It is a necessary evil that all golf courses must undertake at certain times of the year. It is a time consuming and labor-intensive process. We close for a few days each year for this procedure and to give the crew full access to the golf course without having to worry about daily play. The grounds staff will be working diligently to return our playing conditions back as soon as possible.

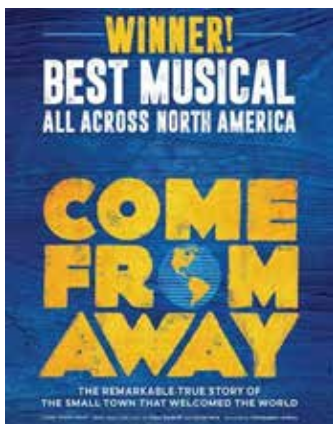

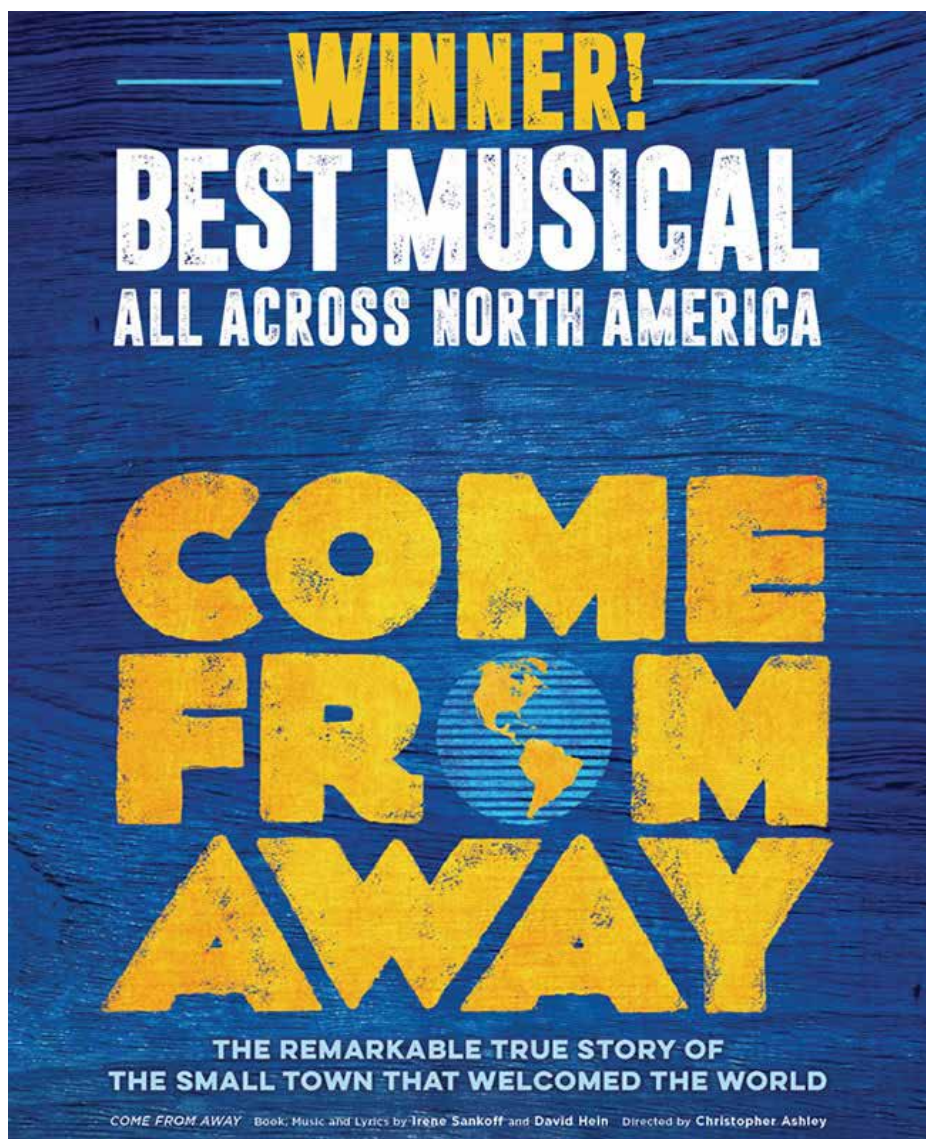

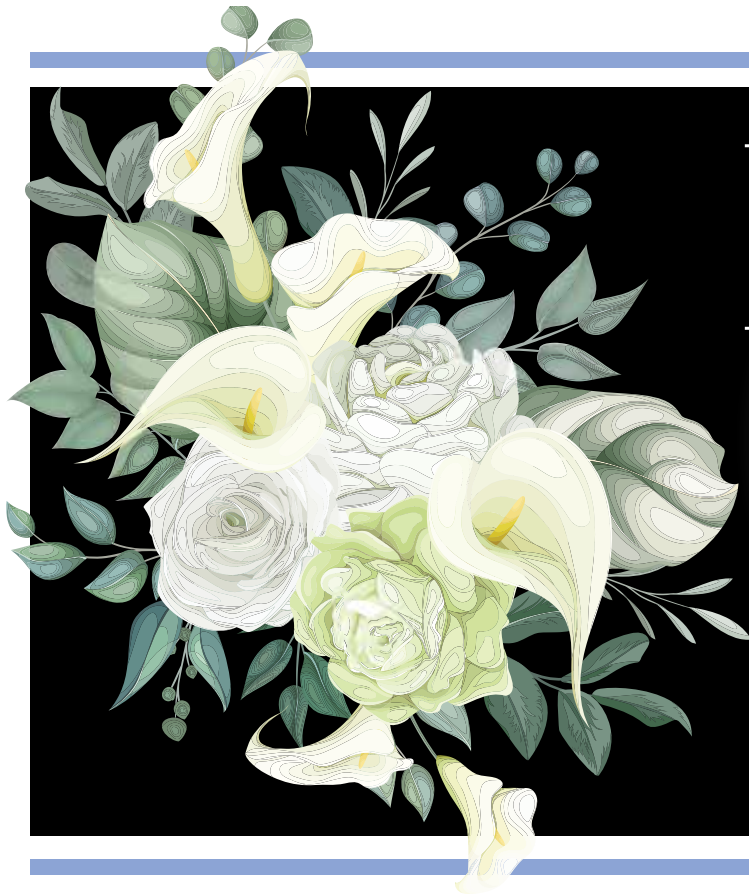
