GOVERNMENT & UTILITY CHARGES

Please be advised that anyone who has not paid the charges in January will receive a "Payment Demand" notice. Payments made will go to any outstanding charges first. FERAL CATS, FLORIDA SANDHILL CRANES AND OTHER WILD ANIMALS

Please do not feed feral cats, Florida Sandhill cranes or other wildlife in the community. They become a nuisance to your neighbors when they see you as their food source. It also can attract other animals to the area or create animals digging under your home or creating other damage to your home or your neighbor's home. It is your responsibility to hire a licensed and insured trapper when wild animals become a problem for you and your home. Please consider everyone in the community before feeding any wildlife. Thank you.

VISITORS COMING INTO THE COMMUNITY

Please be advised that anyone coming in Crane Lakes will need to know your address in order to come into the community. If they do not know your address, they will be required to call you to get the address before being allowed in. If you are unavailable, they will not be allowed to enter Crane Lakes. Please make sure all visitors or guest know your address before approaching the gatehouse to eliminate any problems. No vehicle is allowed to come in after 9:00 pm unless you call the gatehouse and let them know you are expecting a visitor. Thank you

SPEEDING Please be advised that the speed limit in the community is 20 m.p.h. The management office is receiving many complaints about speeding vehicles within the community. GARBAGE CAN REQUIREMENT

The State of Florida conducted an inspection of Crane Lakes recently and cited our community for violation of section 64E-15.007 of the Florida Administrative Code. This section reads as follows:

***Chapter 64E-15, Florida Administrative Code
Mobile Home, Lodging, and Recreational Vehicle Parks and Recreational Camps
Section 64-15.007 Garbage and Refuse Disposal***

- (1) Garbage and refuse shall be stored, collected and disposed of in a manner that does not create nuisances, odors, rodent harborage, insect breeding, accident hazards, or air pollution.*
- (2) All garbage shall be stored in containers that are impervious to water and rodent vectors and have tight-fitting lids. Containers shall be provided in number to prevent garbage overflow. Portable bulk units for central storage shall be covered when not in use and cleaned on a scheduled basis.*
- (3) All garbage shall be collected twice weekly or in accordance with the frequency of the collection jurisdiction and transported in covered vehicles or covered containers. Burning of refuse in the park or camp is prohibited, except in incinerators for which the design and location has been approved by the Department of Environmental Protection. Refuse shall be transported and disposed of in accordance with provisions of Chapter 62-701, F.A.C., Solid Waste Management Facilities.*

Rulemaking Authority 381.011, 513.05 FS. Law Implemented 381.006(4), (14), 386.041, 513.012 FS. History—New 5-20-96, Formerly 10D-26.160, Amended 12-30-09.

The State of Florida will conduct a follow-up inspection and can impose penalties if our community is not in compliance with the code at that time. These penalties are likely to be passed on to the non-compliant residents. Unfortunately, we have been told that the City of Port Orange does not provide garbage cans.

Please place your garbage in a can to comply with the code and to prevent animals from tearing your bags and making a mess.

We appreciate your cooperation.

Government and Utility Charges

As a reminder, your Government and Utility Charges were due January 1, 2026 in the amount of \$937.89. Please pay immediately to prevent late fees.

Golf RULE of the Month

What to do if you hit the **WRONG** ball

Playing the wrong ball in stroke play requires a two stroke penalty. It doesn't matter how many times the wrong ball is played its just a two stroke penalty. If two players play the wrong ball they each get the two stroke penalty. The error must be corrected prior to teeing off on the next hole. If not the penalty is disqualification. In match play the player that hit the wrong ball first loses the hole. If it cannot be decided who hit the wrong ball first proceed play continues with the exchanged golf balls.

Tips from the Tee

“Best Putting Tip Ever”

One of the best putting tips I have ever received came the night before I played in my first PGA Tour Event. As you might assume the greens on Tour are incredibly firm and fast and because of that the ball usually doesn't stop close to the hole. So those tap-ins we are all used to are now 3-5 foot putts. I was struggling to hit my short putts solid enough to make them consistently. Chris Dimarco who is a friend of mine and was a top player on the PGA Tour at the time gave me some great advice. He said “you need to learn to hit your short putts **HARD!**” I was taking the putter back way too far and having to govern how much energy was being delivered to the ball in the forward stroke. I shortened my backstroke to what I thought was the absolute shortest length to make the putt. With the backstroke being so short I had to accelerate the putter head slightly. I went on to make the cut that week in my first PGA Tour event and that tip has stuck with me ever since. Learn to hit your short putts **HARD (SOLID)!**
