From The Management Office...



ATTENTION RESIDENTS

To protect yourselves, please use licensed and insured contractors per the prospectus. It might be a good idea for you to know the background of anyone you invite onto your home site for any reason. You are responsible for the conduct of persons you invite into the community.

SPRINKLERS

As a reminder when doing work in flowerbeds or in the yard such as: placing rock, placing mulch, removing plants, placing or removing a tree, adding a deck or any other item that affects sprinklers to call the office and request a work order for the sprinklers to be flagged approximately a week prior to any work done. This will prevent broken sprinklers/pipe or covering up sprinklers. You will also need to fill out a Design Specification Approval form for pre-approval.

SPEEDING/RESIDENT GATE

Please be advised that the speed limit in the community is 20 MPH. **The management office is receiving complaints with speeding cars and golf carts.** Please do your part and watch your speed and please advise guest(s) to do the same. We need to make sure everyone abides by the speed limit for the safety of all. Thank you for your help in this matter.

PETS

Please be reminded that pets must be on a leash at all times **(including cats)** and are not allowed to be tied up outside or running loose at any time. You may walk them in the streets or on the sidewalk. All pet droppings must be picked up and discarded sanitarily at all times. You may not walk them on the golf course or in your neighbor's yard. Common Areas are acceptable except for the pool area. Management has received numerous complaints. Please follow the rules for all your pets.

SNOWBIRD

If you are getting ready to leave for the summer, please be sure to inform the office when you will be leaving and when you are planning to return. This helps us to locate you if we need to contact you. Thank you in advance.

DESIGN SPECIFICATION APPROVAL FORM

AS A REMINDER:

Anything you do on the outside of your home, you need to fill out a **Design Specification Approval** form with all measurements, colors and diagram of what you would like to do. This includes tree removal, tree placement, adding concrete or additions, painting shutters, adding or changing windows, adding screen or anything else you want to do on the **outside of your home**. Once you fill out the form, we will either approve it or not and let you know. If a permit is required, you will need to get the permit from the City of Port Orange before you can start any of the work. You can pick up the form in the office or if you have any questions, please give us a call. Thank you.

WALKING ON THE GOLF COURSE

Please be reminded that residents and guest are not allowed on the golf course or paths unless playing golf. This also includes being in a golf cart. It is for the safety of everyone. We are asking everyone to abide by this rule. Thank you in advance.

CRANE LAKES ONLINE PAYMENTS

FINAL NOTICE - ACTION REQUIRED

If you wish to continue making payments by ACH (bank transfer), you must switch to the new online payment system. The current payment system is being discontinued and will no longer be available soon.

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR YOU

- You will no longer be able to use the old system
- To continue ACH payments (no-fee option), you must register in the new system
- Residents who do not switch may experience payment disruptions

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO NOW

- Locate the letter or email previously sent to you
- Use the QR code or registration link provided
- Create your new account
- Link your property using your account number
- Select ACH or another payment method

REMINDER

- This system also allots for one time payments
- Payment by check will still be available

Prevention Tips to Stop Scammers

Imposters are real, but their requests are not. Don't be fooled, no matter how "real" or "urgent" they seem. Their goal is to deceive, yours is to detect and protect.

STOP — Don't let anyone rush you. If someone asks for money or personal info and it feels "off," it probably is. Trust your instincts and don't engage with them.

VERIFY — Even if the request appears legitimate, talk it over with someone you trust, like a friend or family member. You can call back using trusted and known numbers, such as those listed on the back of your debit or credit card or on your statement.

PREVENT — Knowing the signs of a scam and sharing them with family and friends can build community awareness. Help others stay alert and avoid scams by spreading the word.

PROTECT — Don't reuse passwords or PIN numbers for multiple accounts. Create complex passwords. Use two-factor authentication and biometrics that create additional steps to your account access.



Watch for Red Flags



Surprise! An unexpected call, text, email or social media message can catch you off guard. Be aware of common scam tactics. They change all the time, but the red flags remain the same. Even if a story makes sense, verify the information through a trusted source.

FALSE URGENCY — Scammers may say there's a problem that needs your immediate attention. They want you to act before you think, so they'll rush you into making hasty decisions. Slow down and consult with a friend or family member.

EMOTION — Scammers use stories to make you feel fear, greed, sympathy or love and urge you to ignore your instincts or lie about why you're moving money.

IMPERSONATION — They'll pretend to be an official, company representative, bank, or even a friend or family member.

DECEPTION — You may be instructed not to trust your bank, told to ignore warning messages or coached on what to say — including to lie.

REWARDS OR THREATS — They may offer money, a job, a prize, make claims of an emergency, or threaten you with legal action or notifying law enforcement.

UNUSUAL PAYMENTS — Scammers may tell you to send money or payment in a less common way, such as a wire transfer, gift cards, or non-traditional forms of payment like gold, cryptocurrency or pre-loaded debit cards.

VERIFICATION CODES — Scammers may try to "confirm" your identity with a verification code that appears to come from your bank but was triggered by the scammer. It's a red flag if they called you.



Golf RULE of the Month

STROKE PLAY:

Stroke play: If the player's ball in motion hits another ball at rest on the putting green and if both balls were on the putting green before the stroke, the player gets the general penalty (two penalty strokes).

Tips from the Tee

BALANCE = Better Ball Striking!!

A simple way to improve contact is to hold your finish for 3 seconds after every swing! If you can't hold your finish, your swing was likely off balance. Practice this during your warm-up before every round and you will be ready to have better balance as well as better ball striking.

A Home Safety Reminder About Our Aging Electrical Systems

I recently had a situation in my home that I wanted to share as a reminder that as we age our homes are aging right along with us and might require health checks too.

My house is 23 years old, and until recently the electrical system was still the original one installed when the home was built. What prompted me to call an electrician was discovering that my dryer outlet had overheated. The plug had actually melted and fused to the outlet and the wall behind it had been scorched. It was a sobering moment realizing how close this could have come to causing a serious electrical fire.

After an inspection, the company I contacted explained that many homes, especially manufactured homes, built 20–25 years ago were not designed for the electrical demands we place on them today. Between larger appliances, electronics, and constant charging of devices, our systems often operate closer to their limits than we realize. Over time, outlets, wiring connections, and panels can wear or loosen, increasing the risk of overheating.

I decided to upgrade my electrical panel and replace several components. The work was done professionally and efficiently, and the peace of mind knowing my system is now operating safely is worth every penny.

If your home is similar in age, it may be worthwhile to have a licensed electrician inspect your panel, outlets, and major appliance connections—especially dryer outlets, which carry a heavy electrical load.

I feel especially lucky to still have my home standing!

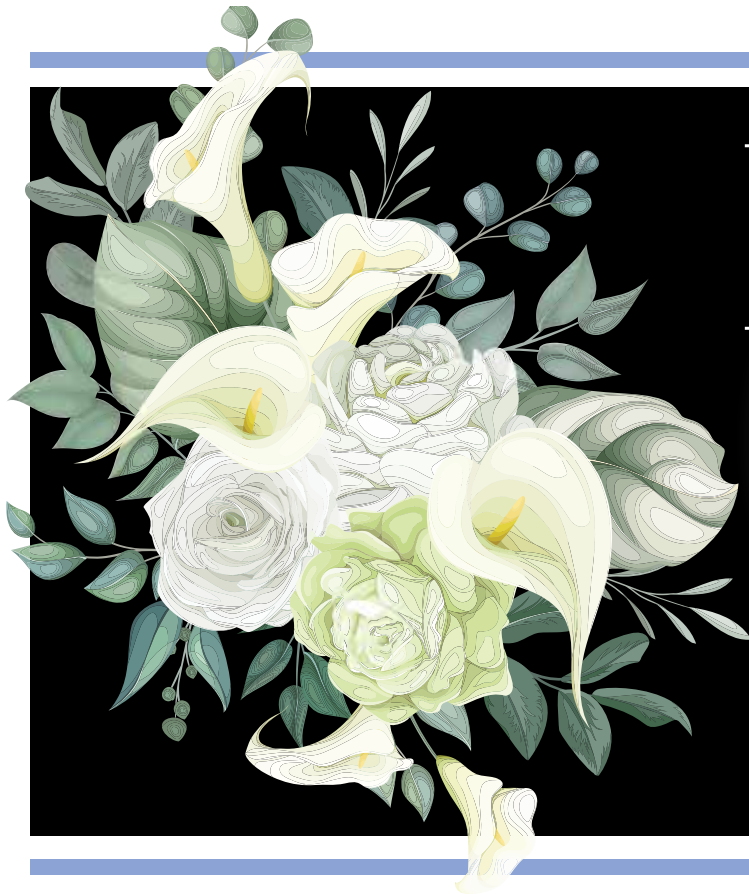

13. No animals in the pool, spa. Or on pool deck.
14. No loud Radios.
15. **Guest under the age of 18 are allowed in the heated pool only during the month November thru April.**
16. **Toddlers must have swimming diapers (swimmies) to be allowed in the pool.**
