# From The Management Office...



## **ATTENTION RESIDENTS**

To protect yourselves, please use licensed and insured contractors per the prospectus. It might be a good idea for you to know the background of anyone you invite onto your home site for any reason. You are responsible for the conduct of persons you invite into the community.

## **RENT IS DUE ON THE 1st of EACH MONTH**

Remember, your rent is due on the 1st of each month. Late fees begin accruing on the 7th day of the month. To avoid late fees, please have your rent in the office by the 1st. If you have any questions, please refer to your prospectus. Automatic debit from your checking account is available, just call our office.

## **GARBAGE, RECYCLE AND YARD WASTE**

Please remember that Garbage, Recycle, and Yard Waste may be placed at the side of your driveway no earlier than the night before pickup. If you have contracted someone to trim and weed your lot, please make them aware of our rules and regulations.

## **KEEP STORM DRAINS CLEAR OF DEBRIS**

We need your assistance. Removing any leaves of debris from your neighborhood storm drains will keep the storm Water System work.

Items that should NOT be dumped into the storm water system:

Yard Waste, Garbage, refuse, or litter, Household wastewater, Oil and automotive fluids, Paints, varnishes, and solvents, Herbicides, pesticides, and fertilizers

Please make sure you or anyone you hire does not put any debris on top of any storm drains.

## **OVERNIGHT STREET PARKING**

Please remember street parking is allowed for no longer than 3 consecutive hours during daylight hours. Residents and their guests must park in the driveway or in specially designated areas around the Community. There is no overnight parking allowed on the streets for any reasons. If an emergency vehicle comes in the community, they need to be able to go down all streets. This is a very important rule and someone's life may depend on it.

## **CALLING GATE HOUSE FOR GUEST AFTER 10:00 PM**

As a reminder, you need to call the gatehouse for all family and friends that come after 10 pm or you will be called no matter what time it is. If there is no answer, they will be turned away and not allowed to come into the community. If you have any questions, or concerns, please call the office.

# NEW ONLINE RENT PAYMENT SYSTEM

## ***AS A REMINDER***

As of May 1, 2026, the old auto-draft method of making lot rent payments was discontinued.

If you'd like to continue having your lot rent automatically deducted from your account, you must sign up for the **NEW ONLINE RENT PAYMENT SYSTEM (Tenant Web Access Portal)**. You should have previously received a letter through both email and the U.S. postal service with personalized instructions on how to sign up. If you need this information, please call the office. If you do not sign up for the new system, you'll need to bring a check to the office each month.

There are many residents whose May rent payments have not been received. Please check your bank statement to see if your payment has been deducted. If not, please bring a check to the office.

# Golf RULE of the Month

## Playing the Wrong Ball.

*In stroke play if you play the wrong ball, you incur a two-stroke penalty and must go back and correct your mistake before teeing off on the next hole. If you do not correct your mistake before then you are disqualified. Shots taken with the wrong ball do not count towards your score. In match play (one person is playing directly against another person and not the entire field) the penalty is loss of hole. If both players hit a wrong ball it is the first person who hit the wrong ball loses the hole. If that cannot be determined then both players should finish the hole with the exchanged ball. Always mark your golf ball so it is easily identifiable.*

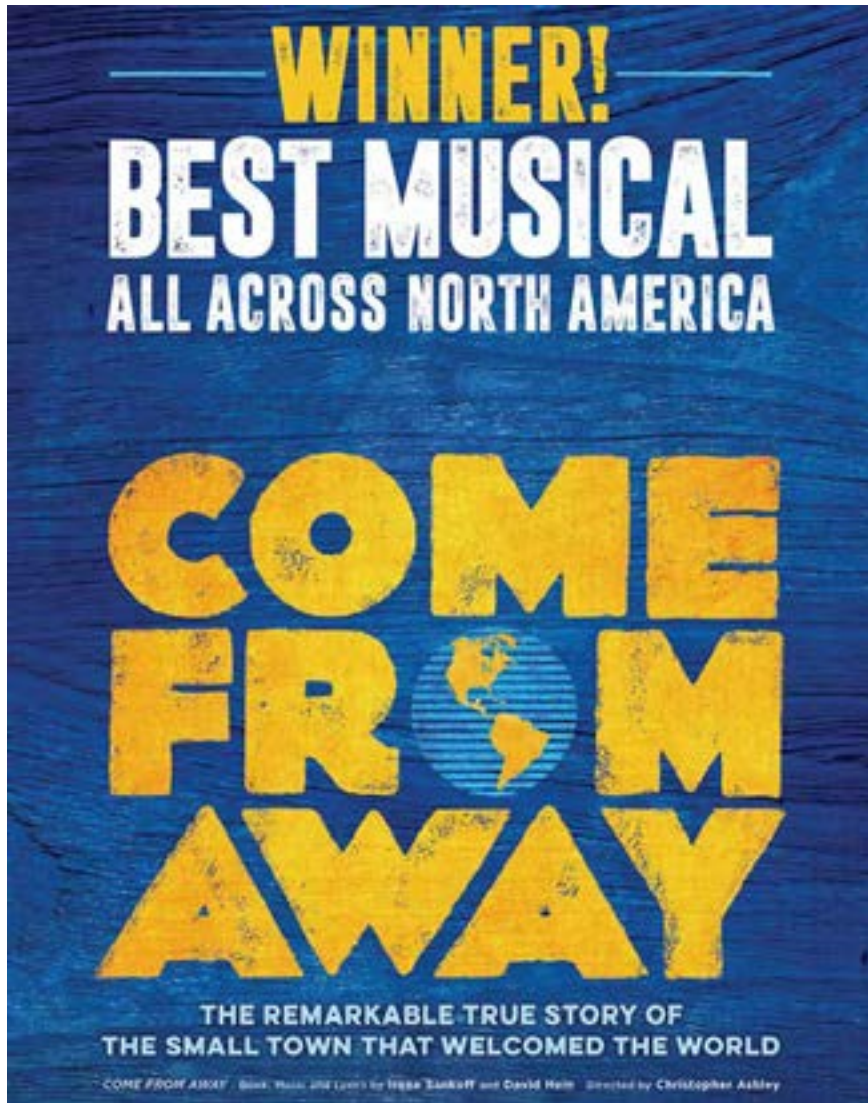

15. **Guest under the age of 18 are allowed in the heated pool only during the month November thru April.**
16. **Toddlers must have swimming diapers (swimmies) to be allowed in the pool.**
