ATTENTION RESIDENTS

To protect yourselves, please use licensed and insured contractors per the prospectus. It might be a good idea for you to know the background of anyone you invite onto your home site for any reason. You are responsible for the conduct of persons you invite into the community.

RENT IS DUE ON THE 1st of EACH MONTH

Remember, your rent is due on the 1st of each month. Late fees begin accruing after the 7th day of the month at an initial \$14.00 and then \$2.00 per day late. To avoid late fees, please have your rent in the office by the 1st. If you have any questions, please refer to your prospectus. ***Automatic debit from your checking or savings account is available, just call our office.***

APPLICATION FOR RESIDENCY, OCCUPANCY OF HOMES, AND RENTERS

Some residents have allowed friends and family to live in their home without proper authorization. All potential residents must fill out our application for residency, have orientation with our office, pass a background check and be in good standing with our rules and regulations. One person in the home must be age 55 or over with other occupants being a minimum age of 40. There are some exceptions to this rule with management approval. This rule includes residents who rent their homes and the persons renting them. Anyone who will be renting your home may do so for a minimum of six (6) months and must comply with the above. Please do not jeopardize the tenancy of yourself and your home by not complying. We do keep an up-to-date HUD census in our office with copies of identification as residents move in and out of our community.

REMEMBER, NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF "40" IS ALLOWED TO LIVE IN CRANE LAKES.

GATEHOUSE ATTENDANTS

Please remember that our gate employees are not security guards and are only considered gate attendants. If you notice anything suspicious (people/vehicles/activity) call the Port Orange Police Department at 911 or 386-756-7400 (non-emergency number). They **are not** trained for dangerous encounters and should not be put in any dangerous situations.

GARBAGE CANS

When putting your garbage out for pick-up, it is now a requirement to have it in a garbage can with a lid. This is a State requirement. Please have your garbage in a can which will also help prevent animals from tearing your bags and making a mess. We appreciate your cooperation.

GARBAGE, RECYCLE AND YARD WASTE

Please remember that Garbage, Recycle, and Yard Waste may be placed at the side of your driveway no earlier than the night before pickup. Please be sure to put your garbage in a garbage can when putting it out. If you have contracted someone to trim and weed your lot, please make them aware of our rules and regulations.

Please do not put any debris on the grass.

Just a Friendly Reminder: Fix your BALL MARKS !!!!

When a golf ball lands on the green it leaves a mark. If that pitch mark is left as is and isn't repaired within a few hours it causes irreversible damage to the green. The generally accepted rule is to fix yours and find 1 more pitch mark to fix. If we all try to leave the golf course better than we found it the course will remain in great condition.



Golf **RULE** of the Month

Golf **RULE** of the Month

True or False? You can touch the sand in a bunker. Surprisingly the answer is TRUE. Let me explain. You are allowed to remove loose impediments, lean on your club, or bring multiple clubs in the bunker and rest them on the sand while hitting your shot. What you can not do is test the sand by taking practice swings, or draw a line in the sand behind or in front of the ball to aid you in any way. You also can not ground your club behind the ball when taking your shot or brush the sand during your backswing. The penalty is 2 strokes in stroke play or loss of hole in match play

Tips from the Tee

Don't lift...**Turn in the backswing!!!!!!**

The correct backswing allows us to create rotational power in the body as well as load the club through the hinging of the wrists. What we want to avoid is lifting the body out of posture. This reduces potential speed and changes the vertical aspect of the swing. If your body is moving up and down during the swing the ball might as well be moving up and down as well. Imagine how hard this game would be if the ball were moving..

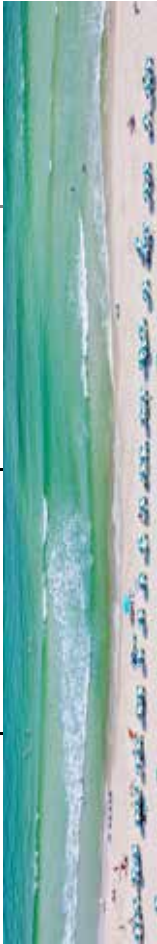

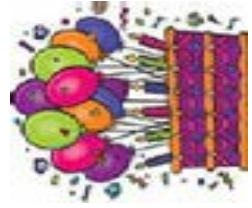

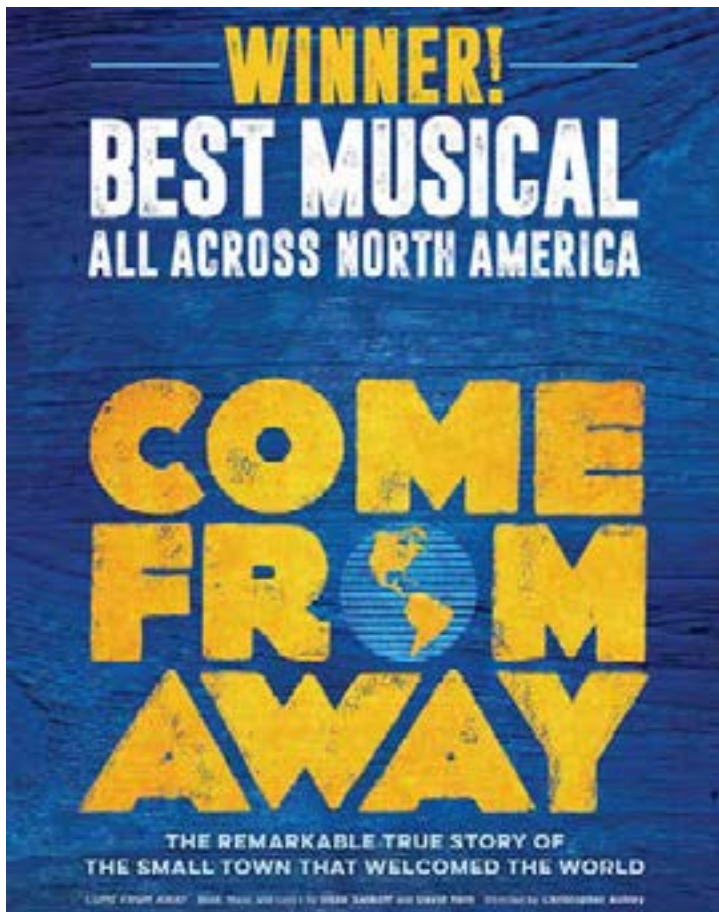
