SHELTER DURING HURRICANE

Hurricane season is upon us. **Please remember that the clubhouse is NOT a hurricane shelter and will be closed.** We have enclosed a list of hurricane information for you to review. Please note that before you go to any shelter to call first and make sure it is open. Some shelters do not take animals and some are for special needs. There is a list of items they suggest to bring to the shelters. Once again, to verify which shelters are available, tune to the local news media or call the number provided on the list. You can also look in your local newspaper for information provided.

PETS

Please be reminded that pets (including cats) must be on a leash at all times. You may walk them in the streets or on the sidewalk. **All pet droppings must be picked up and discarded sanitarily. You may not walk them on the golf course or in your neighbor's yard.** Common Areas are acceptable except for the pool area.

DRAINAGE

The rainy season is here. With the heavy rain, it is normal for water to be standing around your home. You need to check and make sure water is not under your home and if so, take the appropriate action to remove the water. It can create a problem for you. We are not responsible for water under your home.

WALKING, BICYCLES AND SPEED LIMITS

If you are in a vehicle, please watch your speed (20 MPH) and look for pedestrians or bicycles on the streets. We all as a community want to be safe and make sure everyone in here stays safe. Please if you are driving any type of vehicle including a golf cart, you need to watch your speed and be cautious with people walking or on a bicycle. You need to pay attention at all times. If you are walking or on a bicycle, be sure to look both ways before crossing or turning onto another street. This is very important as we do not want to see anyone get hurt and all to be safe.

Golf **RULE** of the Month

Playing a Provisional Ball. _____

*There are only 3 instances where a player can play a provisional ball. A ball that might be out of bounds, a lost ball, or when in doubt about a procedure. A player may **not** hit a provisional ball for a ball that may be in a penalty area which was previously referred to as a water hazards. We recently had one of our junior golfers play a provisional ball for a ball he thought was in the water and was forced to take a maximum score of 10 on that hole. He would have been disqualified in most circumstances. The good news is he did rebound in round 2 and went on to win his age group.*

_____ Tips from the Tee

Get Your Hands **FASTER!!!!!!**

As we age our bodies loose range of motion and rotational speed. Golfers can make up for this unfortunate reality by keeping their hands FAST. The good news is that the majority of the power in the golf swing comes from the elbows to the finger tips. What I am referring to is the lever system the wrists and hands play in the golf swing. Train those hands to get and stay fast and you can keep your clubhead speed up. A great drill is to hold a club about 1/2 down the shaft so it is balanced and rotate the club in a circle as big and fast as you can. Another one is to hit some range balls with your feet together and not move your body or arms. Just try to hit the ball as hard as you can using only your hands.

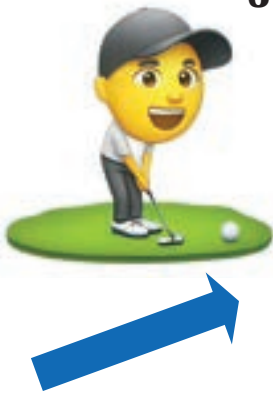

Just a Friendly Reminder: When your house gets hit by a Golf Ball

Let's face it if you live on a golf course or even near a golf course your house has a chance of getting hit by an errant golf ball. I don't think it's ever an intentional act but rather just an accident. The player who hit the golf ball is ultimately responsible. Hopefully they do they right thing and take responsibility for their actions and cover the cost of fixing the damage they caused. Our Golf Staff goes to great lengths to inform golfers that they are responsible for damages they cause when playing. If you as the homeowner are certain what golfer caused the damage then you have the right to address the issue directly with the player. We do ask that when you address the player you do so in a civilized manner. As tensions escalate during these conversations the outcome very rarely results in the golfer taking responsibility. If you as the homeowner are absolutely certain of the golfer who caused the damage and they are unwilling to take responsibility for their actions then please call the Golf Shop (386-767-4653) and one of our Golf Professionals will take the appropriate steps to address the golfer.
