RENT INCREASES.CABLE AND GOVERNMENT & UTILITY CHARGES

By this time, you should have received your rent increase notice. Please remember the new amount takes effect January 1, 2027. The government and utility charges are due at that time as well. You may begin paying the government and utility charges before that date, but it must be paid in full by the 1st of January 2027 to Crane Lakes. Make sure all checks are payable to Crane Lakes, and please indicate what you are paying for on your check. The total amount for the government and utility charge is \$1027.91. Residents who have signed up for the automatic payment on line with no maximum amount your taxes will come out with your payment in January 2027 automatically. If you have any questions, please call the office. Please note: Cable Fee will increase January 1, 2027 to \$69 50.

Golf **RULE** of the Month

Golf **RULE** of the Month _____

Crane Lakes Cup is coming up!

Major Rules of Match Play vs. Stroke Play

1. You may concede your opponent's next stroke at any time.
2. The person who is furthest from the hole MUST play first. If you play out of turn, your opponent has the right to recall your stroke and make you hit it again in the proper order (no penalty).
3. In match play, if you give wrong information to your opponent, you lose the hole.
4. If you hit a wrong ball you lose the hole. However, if you and your opponent accidentally exchange balls during play of a hole, and neither of you can figure out who hit the wrong ball first, then you complete the hole with the balls exchanged.
5. If you are in doubt as to how to proceed because you are unsure about a rule, there is no provision for playing two balls. You must make a decision and continue playing. If your opponent disagrees with that decision, he can make a claim and the matter will be resolved by the Committee.
6. If you play from outside the teeing ground, there is no penalty. You will either play the ball as it lies, or replay it (if your opponent requires you to do so).
7. There is a one-stroke penalty if you move your opponent's ball at any time other than during a search. The moved ball must be replaced.
8. If your ball hits your opponent or his equipment, you have two choices – play it as it lies, or cancel the stroke and replay it.
9. If your ball hits your opponent's ball there is no penalty even if both balls are on the putting green.

**THE MATCH IS OVER WHEN ONE PERSON/TEAM IS UP BY MORE HOLES
THAN ARE LEFT TO PLAY.**

THERE IS NO NEED TO CONTINUE TO PLAY ALL 18 HOLES.

Tips from the Tee

Golf is a Front foot game!

Golf is just like the majority of the other sports we play with the weight on our front foot at impact or release. Think about throwing a baseball or skipping a stone across a pond. This kinematic sequence of shifting our weight from the back foot to the front foot is a HUGE source of power. If the weight remains on the trail foot there will be very little power in the golf swing. Its also makes it virtually impossible to creating a descending strike on the ball which is required whenever the ball is on the ground. To get better at this shift try this drill of stepping forward with your trail foot (right foot for right handed players) in the downswing.

Don't let your weight get stuck on that back foot!
